開会挨拶 / Opening Remarks



日下一正

一般財団法人 国際経済交流財団 会長

1970年東京大学法学部卒、1977年プリンストン大学院修士。IEA省エネ部長、経済産業省産業技術環境局長、通商政策局長、資源エネルギー庁長官、経済産業審議官、内閣官房参与、三菱電機専務執行役を歴任。国際経済交流財団会長、東京大学公共政策大学院客員教授を兼任。

Kazumasa Kusaka has been Chairman and CEO of the Japan Economic Foundation (JEF) since April 1, 2013, and is also a Professor at University of Tokyo Graduate School of Public Policy. He previously served for 36 years in Japan's Ministry of International Trade and Industry (MITI), rising to become vice-minister for international affairs in the reorganized Ministry of Economy, Trade and Industry (METI) in 2004. During his long career in public service, Kusaka was seconded to the International Energy Agency (IEA)/OECD and was Japan's senior official for Asia-Pacific Economic Cooperation (APEC). He played a central role in Asia's economic integration, promoting FTAs in the region as well as serving as a senior official negotiating the Doha development agenda of the WTO. He was head of Japan's Energy Agency and held director-general positions in technology and environmental policy in addition to trade and investment-related areas within METI. He was also instrumental in finalizing the Kyoto Protocol, and developing Japan's energy and environment policies. Among many other posts Kusaka has held are Special Adviser to the Prime Minister on Global Warming, senior vice president of Mitsubishi Electric, executive adviser to Dentsu Inc., and president of the Japan Cooperation Center for the Middle East.

1979年、商工中金入行(東京で中小企業向け金融業務等、ニューヨークのウォール街で為替トレーダー等)。 1995年、世界銀行・海外民間投資促進コンサルタント(サブ・サハラ開発局)としてマダガスカルおよびモーリシャスへの日系・東南アジア系中小企業進出促進プログラムに参画。日系43社のミッション参加企業を募って両国に引率(複数の成功案件成立)。世界銀行原資の中小企業向け新金融機関FASPをマダガスカルに設立。 1996年、英国通商産業省・上級貿易アドバイザー(初代)に就任。新設官庁・英国海外貿易総省(現Department for International Trade)設立業務等にも従事。

1999年、英国海外貿易総省・上級貿易アドバイザー(初代)に就任。

2001年、エジプト政府支援のため産業振興調査に従事。

2005年、独立系の在英シンクタンクKomatsu Research & Advisory (KRA)設立。

2008年、マダガスカル共和国大統領・特別顧問に就任。同国でクーデター発生後に主要業務が経済開発から 正当政権復帰のための外交活動にシフト。5年ぶりの同国民主選挙によって2014年に新共和国大統領が誕生。

欧州、中東、アジア、ロシア、北米、アフリカ等を中心に、全世界を対象市場とする新規ビジネス機会およびカントリー・リスクの情報収集・分析調査・報告・提案に従事。

企業へのアドバイザリー業務の他、ジェトロ・シニアフェロー。JOGMEC(石油天然ガス・金属鉱物資源機構)、JICA(国際協力機構)、NEXI(日本貿易保険)、JBIC(国際協力銀行)、JFC(日本政策金融公庫)、JEF(国際経済交流財団)等でも調査業務。

現在は、環インド洋経済圏の創出・拡大を視野に同地域でも活動中。

Dr. Keiichiro Komatsu (DPhil in International Relations, University of Oxford) is the Principal of London-based think tank Komatsu Research and Advisory (KRA), established in 2005. He is also a JETRO Senior Fellow, and has had distinguished careers in both business and academia. KRA is an expert in business development and country risk-analysis with global coverage, though with particular focus on Europe, the Middle East, Asia, Russia, North America, and Africa. KRA's past clients include JOGMEC, JICA, NEXI, JBIC, and JFC, and it is currently focusing on developing an economic zone centred on the Indian Ocean Rim.

From 1979-1989, he worked for the Japanese semi-governmental Central Co-operative Bank for Commerce and Industry (The Shoko Chukin Bank), firstly in Tokyo and then as Assistant Vice-President in New York. He also worked as a currency trader on Wall Street. In 1995, he joined the Sub-Sahara Development Bureau at the World Bank as the Foreign Direct Investment (FDI) Consultant, where he matched Japanese, South Korean, Malaysian, and Indonesian SMEs with companies in developing countries. He was particularly in charge of planning an economic mission to Madagascar and Mauritius in 1996 for which he secured the participation of 43 Japanese companies covering many different market sectors. He was also involved in establishing the financial banking institution for Malagasy SMEs known as FASP (fonds d'appui au secteur privé).

After working at the World Bank, he has held several positions: Senior Trade Advisor to the British government's Department of Trade and Industry (DTI) and subsequently British Trade International (now known as Department for International Trade); industrial researcher for JETRO in Egypt; and Special Advisor to the President of the Republic of Madagascar.

マシュー・グッドウィン

英国ケント大学ラザフォード・カレッジ教授(政治学)、王立国際問題研究所(Chatham House)客員上級研究員。英国バース大学で博士号を取得。英国と欧州の政治、過激主義、移民、欧州懐疑主義等を専門とする。BBC News、ブルームバーグ、Sky News、アルジャジーラ、Radio 4、CNN等のメディアで幅広く活躍。

グッドウィン教授の研究は、各方面から高く評価されている。2014年には、政治学への貢献が評価され、 リチャード・ローズ賞を受賞。さらに、同年、社会科学の研究をより幅広い人々に届けていることが認知され、 コミュニケーター賞を受賞。2015年には、英国マンチェスター大学、ロバート・フォード教授との共著 「Revolt on the Right」が、Paddy Power Political Book of the Year(英国)を受賞。

グッドウィン教授は、様々な役割を兼任している。2008年以来、ルートレッジ出版のシリーズ「Extremism and Democracy」の共同編集者。2013年以来、英国政治学会(Political Studies Association)の評議員。また、2011年~2015年には、イスラム教徒に対するヘイト(憎悪)に関する英国政府のワーキング・グループの一員を務めた。グッドウィン教授は、社会科学は学界のみでなく社会全体に貢献すべきものだと考えている。

Professor Matthew Goodwin (PhD, University of Bath) is Professor of Politics at Rutherford College, University of Kent, and Visiting Senior Fellow at the Royal Institute of International Affairs, Chatham House. He is known for his work on Britain and Europe, radicalism, immigration and Euroscepticism. He contributes regularly to debates and discussions on BBC News, Bloomberg, Sky News, Al Jazeera, Radio 4, CNN and many more.

His contribution to research has been recognised by several bodies. In 2014, he was recipient of the Richard Rose Prize for his distinctive contribution to the study of politics. In the same year, he was awarded the Communicator Prize for his dissemination of social science research to a wider audience. In 2015, he won the Paddy Power Political Book of the Year for Revolt on the Right, co-authored with Robert Ford.

Professor Goodwin has several other roles and responsibilities. Since 2008 he has been co-editor of the Routledge book series on Extremism and Democracy. Between 2011 and 2015 he served as a member of the UK government's working group on anti-Muslim hatred. Since 2013 he has been a Trustee and member of the executive committee of the Political Studies Association, a leading association for the study of politics that was founded in 1950. Professor Goodwin is an outward-facing researcher who shares the view that social science should be as much about contributing to wider society as to the social sciences.

ラミアリソン・ヘリンザトゥブ・エメ

マダガスカルのアンタナナリボ国立大学教授(経済学)。明治大学で博士号(コマース)を取得。アンタナナリボ大学の研究所ODRESのディレクターを務める傍ら、欧州連合(EU)出資の国際的研究プロジェクト NOPOORの科学主任も務める。また、IMFサブサハラ・アフリカ専門家委員12人のうちの1人でもある。

専門地域は、サブサハラ・アフリカ、マダガスカル、東アジア等。研究分野は幅広く、援助問題、産業促進政策、マクロ経済、経済成長理論、公共政策、雇用、労働市場、開発経済、国際貿易等。

現職に就く前は、ジェトロ・アジア経済研究所(IDE-JETRO)との共同研究プロジェクト 'Prospects of Garment Industry in Madagascar'の共同ディレクター、マダガスカル労働省の公的関連機関であり、労働市場分析や雇用問題を扱うOMEFのディレクター、マダガスカル経済産業相の特別顧問等を歴任。英語、フランス語、日本語で多数の論文や著書の発表実績を持つ。数多くの著名な国際会議等にも招聘されて参加している。

Professor Ramiarison Herinjatovo Aimé (PhD in Commerce from Meiji University, Japan) is the Professor of Economics at the University of Antananarivo. He also acts as the Director of ODRES (research laboratory) at the University of Antananarivo, as well as the scientific supervisor of the international research project NOPOOR for Madagascar, which is financed by the European Union. He is one of the 12 eminent specialists of the IMF Advisory Group on sub-Saharan Africa.

Specialised in the regions of Madagascar, Sub-Saharan Africa, and East Asia, he has a wide-ranging research area, including aid issues, industrialisation, macroeconomics, economic growth, public policy, employment, labour market, development economics, and international trade.

Prior to taking up the current positions, he worked as the Co-Director of the research project 'Prospects of Garment Industry in Madagascar' in partnership with the Institute of Developing Economies (IDE-JETRO) (Japan); the Director of OMEF, a public organisation affiliated to the Ministry of Labour and Civil services (Madagascar) which is in charge of labour market analysis and employment issues; and Special Adviser to the Minister of Economy, Trade, and Industry of Madagascar. He has many publications in English, French, and Japanese, and has participated in several high-level international conferences.

通商産業省を1993年退官。サントリー役員を経て、2000~2004年にかけ、森内閣および小泉内閣において、環境大臣、外務大臣、内閣総理大臣補佐官(外交担当)を歴任。2005年より参議院議員を二期務め、2013年政界を引退。

参議院議員時代、福田総理の要請を受け、核不拡散・核軍縮に関する国際委員会(ICCND)共同議長を元豪外務大臣のギャレス・エバンズ氏と共に約2年間務め、核ゼロ世界に向けた政策提言書を公表。

政界引退後も、世界海洋委員会(GOC)委員、International Crisis Group(ICG)理事、安全保障・正義・統治委員会(Commission on Global Security, Justice and Governance)委員、アジア・ソサエティー政策研究所(Asia Society Policy Institute (ASPI))名誉フェロー兼評議員など、政策提言のための有識者委員会での国際的な活動に従事。外交・安全保障(アジア太平洋の新秩序、核不拡散・核軍縮)や環境政策(地球温暖化対策、海洋政策)を中心に国際的な会議やシンポジウムで活動。2017年春の叙勲で、旭日大綬章を受章。

Ms. Yoriko Kawaguchi is a former Member of the House of Councilors for the Liberal Democratic Party from 2005 to 2013. She was Special Adviser to the Prime Minister of Japan on foreign affairs from 2004 to 2005; Minister for Foreign Affairs from 2002 to 2004 and Minister of the Environment from 2000 to 2002. She also served as Co-chair of the International Commission on Nuclear Non-Proliferation and Disarmament from 2008 to 2010; Prior to this, Ms. Kawaguchi was a Managing Director of Suntory Ltd, Director General of Global Environmental Affairs at the Ministry of International Trade and Industry, and Minister at the Embassy of Japan to the United States. Recently after holding a professorship at Meiji Institute for Global Affairs (MIGA), Meiji University from 2013 to March 31, 2017, Ms. Kawaguchi holds a fellowship at MIGA since April 1, 2017. Her recent activities include Member of the Board of Trustees, International Crisis Group; Council Member and Distinguished Fellow, Asia Society Policy Institute; Member of the Board of Trustees, United States-Japan Foundation; Commissioner, the Great Britain Sasakawa Foundation and so on. Ms. Kawaguchi holds an M.Phil in Economics from Yale University and a BA in International Relations from the University of Tokyo. Ms. Kawaguchi was awarded the Order of the Grand Cordon of the Rising Sun in May, 2017.
